These guidelines have been developed based on information provided by the partner institutions and by professional credential evaluation organizations. Any questions about grade or credit equivalency should be addressed to the Study Abroad Office.

CREDIT HOURS

Massey University utilizes a credit system. Most classes (called “papers”) have a weight of 15 Massey credits and are worth 4 BSU credits. A typical load at Massey is 60 credits/4 papers during each term of their exchange abroad. For courses worth more than the approved BSU equivalent, excess credit will be articulated as INSA 400 unless otherwise designated by the academic department(s) on the Request for Study Abroad Credit form.
