



CREDIT HOUR & GRADING CONVERSION FOR:

VICTORIA UNIVERSITY OF WELLINGTON (NEW ZEALAND)

These guidelines have been developed based on information provided by the partner institutions and by professional credential evaluation organizations. Any questions about grade or credit equivalency should be addressed to the Study Abroad Office.

CREDIT HOURS

Victoria University credits are typically designated by AIFS published credit values for the course on their website. For those courses not articulated by AIFS, credit is determined utilizing a numerical credit point system. Courses listed on the Victoria University transcripts for 15 credit points are recommended for 4 U.S. semester credits and 20 credit points for 5 U.S. semester credits. For courses worth more than the approved BSU equivalent, excess credit will be articulated as INSA 400 unless otherwise designated by the academic department(s) on the Request for Study Abroad Credit form.
