CREDIT HOURS

Most courses at Granada meet for 45 contact hours per semester and carry 3 BSU credits. The minimum course load is 12 BSU credits per term. For individual courses worth more than the approved BSU equivalent, excess credit will be articulated as INSA 400 unless otherwise designated by the academic department(s) on the Request for Study Abroad Credit form.
