



**CREDIT HOUR & GRADING CONVERSION FOR**

**Universidad de Salamanca (SPAIN)**

These guidelines have been developed based on information provided by the partner institutions and by professional credential evaluation organizations. Any questions about grade or credit equivalency should be addressed to the Study Abroad Office.

**CREDIT HOURS**

The Universidad de Salamanca uses a contact hour system. Most courses at Salamanca are offered for 45 contact hours and are worth 3 BSU credits. The minimum course load is 12 BSU credits per semester (180 contact hours). Multiple courses at Salamanca may be combined during articulation back to BSU course work. For individual courses worth more than the approved BSU equivalent, excess credit will be articulated as INSA 400 unless otherwise designated by the academic department(s) on the Request for Study Abroad Credit form.
