CREDIT HOURS

The Universidad de Murcia Language & Culture Program uses a credit hour system which relates to contact hours. Each Murcia credit represents 10 contact hours. The minimum course load is 12 BSU credits per semester (18 Murcia Credits). Multiple courses at Murcia may be combined during articulation back to BSU course work. For individual courses worth more than the approved BSU equivalent, excess credit will be articulated as INSA 400 unless otherwise designated by the academic department(s) on the Request for Study Abroad Credit form.

Students must earn the Ball State equivalent of a 5.0 or better to transfer a course from Murcia. The Ball State University transcript will reflect grades of CR or NC, which are not calculated into the student's cumulative grade point average.
