NOTES: The Senate & each council has authority to establish committees, subcommittees, joint committee & resolutions on matters germane to respective constituencies and advisory to the President, with whom they report to directly. The composition of the Senate [23] shall include the constituencies of the three councils plus alumni and the external community served by the University. Each body determines terms on own council and for representatives to Senate. Senate now attends to the direction of the University through its strategic plan & implementation.

The University Senate shall be composed of the following ~~ex officio, non-voting~~ members, composed by virtue of their offices the President of the University, the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs, the chairpersons of the three councils, and one ~~academic dean~~ academic dean selected annually by all such deans to represent them.
