






- SPIN has three distinct search modes:
 - Text
 - search full text of a record to match relevant search terms
 - Keyword
 - Allows a user to see a variety of records that fall under those categories
 - Advanced
 - potential to yield highly relevant results
 - set general search parameters that will affect all three search modes simultaneously
 - filters remain in place regardless of which search mode is used;
 - will remain active across multiple search sessions until the user edits them





Preferences

- These are your filters to help narrow your search including:
 - Applicant Location
 - Applicant Type
 - Project Type
 - Sponsor Type
- Use the "Preferences" drop-down menu to set filters for the type of opportunities that are relevant to your work
- Institutional filters are set to:
 - Applicant Location: United States
 - Applicant Type: Institution of Higher Education> College or University




Admins & Public Searches


