Dr. Joe and Alice Rinard Orchid Greenhouse

With nearly 2,000 orchids, the Rinard Orchid Greenhouse contains the largest university-based orchid collection in the United States, including the Wheeler-Thanhauser Orchid Collection and Species Bank, and Betty Kendall Ladyslipper Orchid Species Collection. The collection is a living museum which provides opportunities for education and conversation of rare and endangered orchid species and it is used for orchid research. The collection also provides the opportunities for students and visitors to learn about a diversity of tropical species. Students, faculty, local schools, community, and visitors can see and learn about orchids, edible tropical plants, poison arrow frogs, birds, and other tropical creatures that are on display in a small tropical environment. The greenhouse is free and open to the public. Both self-guided and guided tours are available.
