Ball State/Ivy Tech

Honors Partnership

Ivy Tech Community College students who graduate with the Honors diploma (24 Honors credit hours) with at least a 3.25 cumulative GPA and are accepted into Ball State University will also be accepted into the Ball State Honors College. We will credit these students' Ivy Tech courses with the "H" (Honors) designation toward completion of the Ball State Honors curriculum. Ball State's HONR 100: Freshman Seminar (0.5 credits) will be waived for these students. Ivy Tech Honors College transfer students will complete three additional requirements to earn the Ball State Honors diploma:

- One 3-credit Honors 390 colloquium course;
- One 3-credit Honors course of the student's choice;
- Senior Honors Project (typically completed through a 3-credit Honors 499 course).

- ➤ Ivy Tech students who have graduated with the Honors Diploma (24 Honors credit hours) and transfer into and persist in the Ball State Honors College with at least a 3.0 GPA will be awarded a \$1,000 scholarship per semester for up to four semesters. These Honors College transfer students will be eligible for additional scholarships, including the **Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship** (worth \$4,500 per year for two years).
- ➤ Undergraduate fellowship funds will be set aside for Ivy Tech Honors College graduates who transfer into the Ball State Honors College.
- ➤ Ivy Tech Honors College students who transfer into the Ball State Honors College will have the opportunity to enroll in the **Pathways Mentoring Program**, an initiative designed to foster equity and mentoring at Ball State University.
- ➤ Ivy Tech Honors College students who transfer into the Ball State Honors College will have the opportunity to earn a minor in African American Studies and/or Women's and Gender Studies through their Ball State Honors coursework.
