Student must have a C or better in Ivy Tech's MATH 141, ENGL 111, COMM 101, ECED 100, ECED 120, ECED 225, ECED 233, ECED 235, ECED 230, ECED 243 and ECED 245.

Due to Indiana state licensing regulations, students will have 63 credits remaining at Ball State.

Students must take Ivy Tech's MATH 141, not 123 or 136 in order to meet licensing regulations.

Student must take Ivy Tech's HIST 101, not HIST 102

Student must take Ivy Tech's ECED 225, ECED 235, or ECED 245 (if in a kindergarten classroom), not ECED 255.

To begin taking 300 level courses, student must have completed decision point 2 and be admitted to the teacher education program.
