## INVENTORY

Before Reading
the Chapter

- 1. Check the syllabus to check the page numbers of the required reading.
- 2. Read the chapter summary
- 3. Read the title page.
- 4. Flip through the chapter and read the heading of the sections; read the definitions of any italicized or boldfaced words (go to the back of the book and look up words in the glossary).
- 5. Create questions to be answered through your reading. Write the questions out on paper if necessary.



- 6. Check your reading against your class notes and make any further notations in the margins of your notebook.
- 7. Try to apply a specific example from your own experiences with a new theory.
- 8. Study diagrams, charts, graphs, and illustrations carefully and extensively.
- 9. Be active in your reading. Make notations and underline or highlight important sections in the chapter.



- 10. Review what you have read.
- 11. Reread your class notes
- 12. Write a summary over the reading in your own words.
- 13. Note any questions to ask the instructor at the next meeting.
