### Student Achievement

In a survey, of the graduating class of 2019: 83 percent of students either agreed or strongly agreed that their education prepared them to analyze data quantitatively. 100 percent agreed or strongly agreed that they were well prepared to work collaboratively with others. 83 percent also agreed or strongly agreed that professors prepared them to understand issues of equity and social justice.

Internship supervisors last year rated our students "above average" or "excellent" in each of a dozen categories and assigned a 7.1 rating out of a possible 8 points.
