Student Achievement

Employers said summer 2024 interns played a strong role in contributing to their organization's overall goals, assigning them a 9.2 on a scale of 1-10. Students scored 8 or above on all areas ranked, including competence in the field, initiative, and professional development. Said one supervisor: "(Student) created our 2023-24 annual report and authored several grants and reports. She has also begun taking on a leadership role in our acquisition and disposition processes, which require significant patience, expertise, and attention to detail." Said another: "She's quick on her feet and solves problems easily. She basically does anything we need with energy and accuracy."

Before they are eligible to undertake an internship for credit toward graduation, students must create a portfolio of their work, highlighting analytical skills, design skills, and writing skills. They present this work to faculty in a formal setting and answer questions about their experiences and their goals. Students are then either given permission to take the internship class or asked to make extensive revisions to receive a passing score and permission to take an internship. 80 percent of 2024 undergraduates passed during the initial review, with all of them passing after revisions. 92 percent of them met or exceeded expectations in the category of analysis, 61 percent met or exceeded expectations in the category of writing, and 76 percent met or exceeded expectations in the category of communications skills.

Our undergraduate GPA is 3.25, another measure of success.
