## **Student Achievement**

Each of our students creates a portfolio of their work during their third year, then goes through a formal review process before receiving permission to embark on an internship. At the conclusion of the internship, both student and supervisor rate the student's performance. Supervisors of our nine student interns gave them an overall score of 7.56 on an 8-point scale, one measure of student achievement we capture each year. "----- far exceeded expectations for the summer internship in Brooklyn Park," wrote one. Another said, "----- has excellent communication skills, takes initiative, and is a very competent planner."

Our job placement rate is already high with 96 percent employment in the field within one year of graduation average for the past five years. Students who interned in the summer of 2023 beat that with five of them securing job offers from organizations they interned for.

Our average undergraduate student GPA is 3.2, another metric of success.
